At this year's Heli Expo in Dallas, RHC displayed an R66 Turbine, R44 Raven II, R44 Cadet, and an R66 Newscopter. All four aircraft were sold and delivered immediately following the exhibit. SKY Helicopters, Robinson's longtime dealer (Garland, Texas) took delivery of three of the four aircraft, the R66, the Raven II and the Newscopter (SKY's 16th). The R66 and the Raven II were displayed in the main hall while the Newscopter was exhibited in the static hall. The R44 Cadet, also displayed in the main hall, was delivered to the University of North Dakota (UND) Aerospace. This is UND's 6th Cadet since its first acquisition in 2016. "The Cadet has proven to be an outstanding trainer... allowing us to instruct the next generation of helicopter pilots," said Wes Van Dell, UND's Chief Flight Instructor-Helicopter.

Robinson Updates Helicopter Community

Robinson President Kurt Robinson addressed a full room at his March 8th Heli Expo press conference. He began with Robinson's aircraft production for 2021. The company produced 244 aircraft in 2021 compared to 177 in 2020 and the upward trajectory is expected to continue. "I'm targeting 300-350 for 2022 but we'll see how it goes, as we are still dealing with residual effects from COVID," said Robinson. He then moved on to the recent upturn in sales, noting the company currently has a backlog of over 300 aircraft orders. Kurt emphasized the R66's strong position in the marketplace (for the first time R66 sales surpassed Raven II sales). "The R66 has found its niche... operators are realizing the vast potential of this aircraft." With over 1,100 R66s delivered and more than 1.5 million hours logged, the R66 has become the number one selling light turbine helicopter according to GAMA's 2021 Year-End Aircraft Shipment Report.




