

**SUBJECT:** Main Rotor Blade Inspection

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> RHC has received reports of debonding at the tips of C934 doublers on C016-2 and -5 main rotor blades. While not an immediate airworthiness issue, inspection every 100 hours is warranted.

## **COMPLIANCE PROCEDURE:**

- 1. During each 100-hour inspection, tap test outboard tips of C934 doublers (top and bottom of blade) as indicated in figure below.
- 2. If debond area exceeds limits, remove rotor blade from service and inform RHC Technical Support of blade serial number and time in service.
