A723-18 Oil Line Assembly Retrofit Kit Instructions

Kit replaces superseded A723-15 oil line assembly with A723-18 oil line assembly. Applicable to R44 S/N 2613 & prior, R44 II S/N 14391 & prior, and Cadet S/N 30068 & prior, with original engine. Removal of MS20823-8 elbow may be difficult; RHC recommends kit be installed when engine is out of helicopter for other maintenance. KI-286-2 is optional, and includes new bead clamps with liners, eliminating the need for CRES tape.

- A701-10 Tape CRES, 1-inch wide (not required if installing KI-286-2)
- B270-6 Sealant

Kit Instructions

- 1. Refer to R44 Illustrated Parts Catalog (IPC) Figures 53-1 and 53-5. Remove D040-1, C377 (LH), and C378 (RH) cowling assemblies.
- 2. R44 II only: Remove airbox assembly per MM § 6.470
- 3. Remove C169 muffler assembly by removing bead clamps to risers/collectors and clamps. **On engine-left (helicopter-right) side only:** remove risers connected to cylinders.
- 4. Remove breather tube or air/oil separator. Cover exposed connection on engine.
- 5. Refer to IPC Figure 79-7. Remove A723-15 oil line (outboard, helicopter-right) and MS20823-8 elbow. Discard oil line and elbow; retain hardware.
- 6. Apply light coat B270-6 sealant to threads on A457-21 elbow; do not apply sealant to first thread. Install elbow and standard torque per MM § 23-32.
- 7. Install A723-18 oil line assembly, aligning elbow as required by rotating in a clockwise (tightening) direction only. Special torque oil line end nuts to 40 ft—lb. Torque stripe per MM Figure 2-1.

Kit Instructions (continued)

- 8. Attach retained MS21919WDG clamps to oil line per applicable IPC § 79 Figure.
- 9. Install breather tube or air/oil separator.
- 10. Install new 77611 gaskets on engine-left side risers to cylinders; special torque nuts per MM § 23-33. Position muffler on risers/collectors and wrap joints under bead clamps with A701-10 tape as required. Install hardware securing bead clamps. Standard torque bead clamp bolts per R44 MM § 23-32. Verify security.
- 11. **R44** II only: Install airbox assembly per R44 MM § 6.480.
- 12. Install D040-1, C377 (LH), and C378 (RH) cowling assemblies.
- 13. With an appropriately rated person at controls, perform starting engine and run-up followed by shutdown checklists per Section 4 of Pilot's Operating Handbook.
- 14. Verify no oil leaks; correct as required.
- 15. Make appropriate maintenance record entries. Weight and Balance change is negligible.
